Western-style conversations develop quite differently from Japanese-style conversations. A Western-style conversation between two people is like a game of tennis. If I introduce a topic, a conversational ball, I expect you to hit it back. If you agree with me, I expect you to add something such as a reason, another example, or an elaboration to carry the idea further. Whether you agree or disagree, your response will return the ball to me. However, a Japanese-style conversation is like bowling. You wait for your turn and you always know your place in line. **It** depends on your age, familiarity, and social status relative to the previous speaker. When your turn comes, you step up to the starting line with your bowling ball and carefully bowl it. Everyone else stands back and watches politely. Then, after everyone is sure that you have completely finished your turn, the next person in line steps up to the same starting line, with a different ball. He does not return your ball, and he does not begin from where your ball stopped. There is no rush for the ball. No wonder everyone looked startled when I first took part in a Japanese conversation. I paid no attention to whose turn it was and kept snatching the ball halfway down the alley and throwing it back at the bowler. Of course the conversation died. I was playing the wrong game.

When we try to teach children, we can experience the frustrations of having these children reject our efforts. Children, in turn, are often frustrated by parents who think teaching is a matter of forcing some learning on them. Therefore to be a good teacher, patience is essential, but it is not enough. A good teacher needs to be able to work up and down on a scale of greater and lesser difficulty. For instance, with a very young kid, you may begin by asking your child to point to something. Then you teach your child to move to “yes” or “no” responses. The next move is to whole sentence answers. Sometimes adults, who need the practice least, do most of the talking, while children sit by passively. **This** is unfortunate, because it is the interplay of discussion and experience that encourages children to use their minds actively to form ideas. Probably the best teaching tip is “Don’t talk too much!” A good teacher keeps explanations short and backs them up with demonstrations. If you are teaching measurement, actually measure a room.
